PICKWICK ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP AND ELECTRIC SERVICE

THIS FORM MUST BE SIGNED AND FILLED OUT COMPLETELY BEFORE SERVICE WILL BE INSTALLED

The undersigned (hereinafter called the "Applicant(s)") hereby applies for membership in and agrees to purchase electric energy from Pickwick Electric Cooperative (hereinafter called the "Cooperative") upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Applicant will comply and be bound by the Cooperative's Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws, and all rules, regulations, rates classifications and rate schedules established pursuant thereto, as the same then exist or may therefore be adopted or amended. Applicant shall, without charge to the Cooperative, grant to it easements over land owned by them for the transmission and distribution lines of the Cooperative. (This includes provisions for allowing the Cooperative to maintain suitable right-of-way across member's property, such as: tree trimming, cutting overhanging limbs, danger trees, etc.)

2. The Applicant shall, as soon as electric energy becomes available, purchase from the Cooperative all electric energy purchased for use on the premises referred to in this application: provided, however that the electric energy which the Cooperative shall furnish to any member may be limited to such amount as the Board of Directors shall from time to time determine.

3. The Applicant will pay the Cooperative the sum of \$5.00 which, if this application is accepted by the Cooperative, will constitute the Applicant's membership fee. It is understood that the Applicant(s) may be asked to pay a service security deposit, service connection fee, facilities extension deposit, or contribution in aid of construction that may be required by the Cooperative.

4. Each member shall cause all premises receiving electric service pursuant to his membership to become and to remain wired in accordance with the specifications of the National Electric Code, any applicable state code or state regulation, local government ordinances, and of the Cooperative. If the foregoing specifications are variant, the more exacting standers shall prevail. Each member shall be responsible for and shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Cooperative and its directors, officers, employees, and independent contractors from all claims, causes of action, losses, liabilities, and expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees) for personal loss, injury, or death to persons and loss, damage to or destruction of Cooperative's property or the property of any person or entity resulting from any defect in or improper use or maintenance of such premises and all wiring and apparatuses connected thereto or used thereon. Each member shall make available to the Cooperative a suitable site, as determined by the Cooperative, whereon to place the Cooperative's physical facilities for the furnishing and metering of electric service and shall permit the Cooperative's authorized employees, agents and independent contractors to have safe access thereto for meter reading and bill collecting and for inspection, maintenance, replacement, relocation, repair or disconnection of such facilities at all reasonable times. As part of the consideration for such service, each member shall be the Cooperative's bailee of such facilities and shall accordingly desist from interfering with, impairing the operation of or causing damage to such facilities, and shall use his best efforts to prevent others from doing so. Each member shall also provide such protective devices to his premises, apparatuses or meter base as the Cooperative shall from time to time require in order to protect the Cooperative's physical facilities and their operation and to prevent an interference with or damage to such facilities. In the event such facilities are interfered with, impaired in their operation or damaged by the member, or by any other person when the member's reasonable care and surveillance should have prevented such, the member shall be responsible for and shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Cooperative and its directors, officers, employees, and independent contractors from all claims, causes of action, losses, liabilities, and expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees) for personal loss, injury, or death to persons and loss, damage to or destruction of Cooperative's property or the property of any other person or entity resulting therefrom, including but not limited to the Cooperative's cost of repairing, replacing or relocating such facilities and its loss, if any, of revenues resulting from the failure or defective functioning of its metering equipment. The Cooperative shall, however, in accordance with its applicable service rules and regulations, indemnify the member for any overcharges for service that may result from a malfunctioning of its metering equipment or any error occurring in the Cooperative's billing procedures. In no event shall the responsibility of the Cooperative extend beyond the point of delivery.

5. It is understood and agreed to by the Applicant(s) that a portion of the equity in the Cooperative accruing to the member each year will be used to pay for a subscription to "The Tennessee Magazine" (a publication of the Tennessee Electric Cooperative Association). The annual subscription price shall be not less than \$2.60, nor more than \$6.00.
