The Pickwick Electric Cooperative (hereinafter called the "Cooperative") and  
\_\_\_\_\_ mutually agree as follows:

- (1) The Cooperative will furnish and install at no expense to the member, a yard light unit, 43 Watt LED, at the location designated by the above member, providing secondary facilities and pole exist, and will make all necessary connections to the photo-cell controlled unit for a fixed rate per month as established by Policy Bulletin.10-24.
- (2) If the member wishes to have the fixture Installed at a location other than on a pole already in place, member agrees to pay a pole rental for each pole used exclusively for the security light fixture. The pole rental will be that fee as established by Policy Bulletin 10-24.
- (3) The member further agrees that the unit, with pole and conductor, shall remain property of the Cooperative and shall be removed at any time upon failure to pay the charges set forth herein. The unit as installed must remain in service for a minimum period of two years. Should the fixture be removed, for any reason, the remaining balance of the contract shall become due and payable; such balance to be billed on the final billing. At the request of the member, the unit may be moved any time after the anniversary of this agreement.
- (4) The member further agrees that they will notify the Cooperative when the light fails to burn, and the Cooperative will make every effort to service the light within five (5) days from notification. The member also agrees to protect the unit from damage insofar as the member is able.
- (5) Charges currently in effect: Outdoor Lighting Rate- Schedule LS
